AUTHENTIC NATIVE AMERICAN ARTS & CULTURE EXHIBIT ENTRY FORM

Central Wisconsin Cultural Center (CWCC) is seeking original artwork by Native American artists for exhibition, July 9 - August 22, 2024, showcasing American Indian art, craft, and culture.

Open to artists than can provide a tribal enrollment card in compliance of The Indian Arts and Crafts Act (IACA) of 1990 (P.L. 101-644). Artwork may be traditional, contemporary or a combination; 2D and 3D are welcome, for example: glass, beading, quill, leather, jewelry, carving, painting, print-making, pottery, weaving, sculpture, photography, etc. Proposals to lead workshops, classes, and/or performances are also welcome.

Entry form must include a \$10 ENTRY FEE (per artist) cash or check payable to CWCC as well as provide a copy of your tribal enrollment card.

- Works will be accepted only if accompanied by a completed 2024 Native American Arts & Culture Exhibition form signed by the artist with payment and a **copy of tribal enrollment card in compliance of The Indian Arts and Crafts Act (IACA)**
- Maximum number of entries: three (3). Entries must be new to Central Wisconsin Cultural Center (CWCC), that is: never submitted to previous exhibits or for sale at CWCC. Original works must be created by the person submitting art. Artists are responsible for their own insurance.
- **All artworks must arrive ready to hang or install.** Pictures must be matted and framed with wire on the back to hang (saw tooth hangers on frames 11x14 or smaller). Thick, gallery style canvas does not require a frame, but must have wire to hang, edges should be finished.
- All work must be clearly labeled on the back with artist name, phone, price or NFS/not for sale, and artwork title. The retail price must include 30% commission to CWCC.
- All artwork submitted must be original & not infringe upon copyright, right of publicity, moral right or any proprietary or other rights of any third party. Unless noted, artists agree to photographic use of their art to be used in CWCC communications - including but not limited to print, online, and social media.
- Works cannot be removed from the exhibit by the artist once they have been entered and must stay on display for the duration of exhibit dates. At their discretion, CWCC staff may allow priced work to be sold and removed before the exhibit end date.
- Abandoned artwork (60 days after August 22, 2024) becomes a donation to CWCC which may donate or sell each abandoned piece and keep the full selling price.
